NB: Students who are **absent** from the regular examination **will not be allowed to write** at a subsequent time, unless they can give a satisfactory reason for their absence. In the case of those who have **not been excused**, the Examination Mark will be **zero**.

If **due to health reasons or other extraordinary circumstances** a student is unable to take an examination, he *may* be allowed to take a supplementary examination *at the faculty's discretion*. Documentary evidence, such as a letter from a doctor, must be provided. **THE REGISTRAR MUST BE INFORMED AHEAD OF TIME.** (Academic Handbook Section 1.1.7 c. p.3) (cf. 1.1.10 b p.3).

NB: Electronic dictionaries are not permitted to be used in the examinations. (Faculty Motion Nov. 5, 2003)

NB: Students are NOT allowed to use THEIR OWN English Bibles, since we provide English Bibles. However, students whose first language is not English ARE allowed to bring in a Bible in their own language. The Bibles must first be checked by the person proctoring the exam, to make sure the Bible does not contain any additional material. Our policy with Bibles is that study bibles are NOT allowed, nor are any Bibles with notes, helps etc. (with the exception of a bare reference Bible).
