



Master of Theology

The Th.M is essentially a non-residential research degree.

Entrance into the degree is dependent upon an overall B+ average or higher in the preceding degree, which should be the Master of Divinity or its equivalent.

It is ideal for the person who would like a stepping-stone to a doctoral degree (especially a European Ph.D. that has no course requirements) or who would simply like a research degree beyond the Master of Divinity.
