Prospective candidates must possess, or be nearing completion of, a relevant doctoral degree, exhibit a passion for theological education and student development, and demonstrate proficiency in online instruction, student oversight, and mentorship. Those adept in an additional discipline will receive special consideration. Essential qualifications include:

- Exceptional command of English (written and verbal) and/or Mandarin
- Experience or training in online andragogy
- Demonstrated ability to write curriculum for both church and academy
- Proven expertise in Christian preaching across cultures
- An active, congregation-centered Christian life, in harmony with the <u>Identity Statement</u> of the Canadian Baptists of Western Canada

A ten-week term teaching a minimum of 6 students offers a minimum stipend of CAD\$4,500. Preference is given to Canadian citizens and permanent residents; however, all qualified candidates are encouraged to apply.
